“The Digital TV Transition” *What does that mean to me?*

Questions & Answers

1. When will the Transition happen?

The Transition will happen Feb. 17th, 2009. That means that all Off Air Reception using a standard TV that does not have a Digital TV (DTV) Tuner or External Digital Converter Box will not receive TV Stations after the transition date.

2. I have a Satellite or Cable TV provider and currently paying for those services. Do I need to be concerned?

You would not need to be concerned. You will still receive what you do today. There may be some change with Cable Cards and possibly with some DVRs on the Cable side. You can contact your local cable provider to confirm on equipment changes if any.

You can add an Off Air Antenna to Your System as a back up or to receive Local Stations in HD without an additional monthly charge. If you need assistance contact us below and get more information at www.TransitionMyTV.com.

3. Can we Convert our Equipment Today?

Yes you certainly can. All local TV stations are broadcast in Digital today.

4. Can I use my existing Analog UHF/VHF Antenna?

If your existing antenna functions well and receives Off Air TV channels today it should receive digital channels without any problem. You will need a TV with a built in Digital Tuner or an External Digital Tuner Set Top Box. An External Digital Converter Box would be connected between your existing Off Air Antenna and your TV.

5. Can we receive HDTV Channels with the Transition?

If you have an HDTV television with a built in Digital Tuner you can receive HDTV stations. If you have an HD Ready TV you can purchase an HDTV Tuner. If you need assistance contact us below and get more information at www.TransitionMyTV.com.

6. Will my existing Off Air Antenna receive HDTV?

Yes. DTV occupies the same spectrum and Analog. Your existing operational Off Air antenna will work with DTV. If you receive a fuzzy or Ghost type signal today with analog TV your DTV may not lock on. You may need to replace the coax running to it and/or add a pre-amp, depending on your specific situation or more antenna based on how far the broadcast towers are from your home. You may get by with a pair of rabbit ears or you may need to invest in a rooftop antenna. In either case you will need a TV with a built in DTV Tuner or External Digital Converter Box to get started. 7. Is there any monthly charges for Off Air DTV?

No there isn't any monthly charge for these services. You may have some up fees for Equipment and Installation Services. If you need assistance contact us below and get more information at www.TransitionMyTV.com or at 888-485-8049.

8. Why is the Digital Transition Happening?

To make a long story short. Broadcasters became interested in HDTV and providing more channels to viewers. Congress decided to have broadcasters move to Digital so they could offer more channels and free up the analog channels for emergency communications and advanced services. This became more important after September 11, 2001.

9. If I am looking to purchase a new TV will it need to be an HDTV to watch digital broadcast television?

No. You can purchase an SD television that is not HD. You may want to make sure it has a Digital Tuner built in or you can purchase an External Digital Converter Box. If you purchase an HDTV television with a built in DTV Tuner you will receive HDTV stations also.

10. Does my TV have a DTV tuner?

You need to check your owner's manual to determine if your TV has a built in DTV or HDTV Tuner. You can also check in the Menu Mode of your TV when you go to scan for TV channels. It should say something to scan for both analog or digital. If it mentions Digital you should be all set. If it is an HDTV with digital you should receive HDTV stations. If your HDTV says it is HDTV Ready it typically has just an analog TV tuner and not a DTV Tuner. You would need to purchase a DTV Tuner. You can purchase an HDTV Tuner to receive HDTV stations. 11. Does my VCR, DVD recorder, PVR, DVR, have a DTV tuner?

Most of the products do not have a DTV Tuner Built in even though they mention that they are digital devices. If you think that it has a DTV tuner, you would need to check your owners manual to determine if your TV has a built in DTV or HDTV Tuner. There are DVR and DVD Players available with built in HDTV Tuners. TransitionMyTV.com can provide that product along with the On Site Set Up and installation.
